ACCREDITATION RULES FOR JOURNALISTS

We want to facilitate the access to the exhibition by means of accreditation. The accreditation is granted solely for the purpose of journalistic coverage.

Following people can obtain the press accreditation:

1. Owner of a valid press card of a domestic or foreign journalistic organization, unrelated to the sector
2. Owner of a valid press card of a domestic or foreign specialized journalistic organization, with thematic reference to the fair
3. People from home and abroad, who can demonstrate their journalistic (or photojournalistic) activities as follows:
 - a) By presenting current personal articles in the original, which, at the time of the event, are not older than six months.
 - b) By presenting a current imprint in the original, in which they are mentioned as editors, permanent editorial staff or authors. This imprint is, at the time of the event, not older than six months.
 - c) By presenting a written order in the original with reference to the current fair.
 - d) By use of a weblink to a self-provided branch-relevant online-publication. In these instances a accreditation in advance for an increased effort of control is necessary.

Besides the organizer of the fair reserves the further validation of the proof of journalistic activity, even in case of a press card. The legitimation should be submitted in German or English.

The organizer of the fair reserves the right in a given case, also to urge a submission of a valid identity document with a photo. The right of an accreditation does not exist. As the case may be the organizer of the fair avails its householder's rights.
